Dear Parents,

I would like to thank all of our community members for a great start to this new school year. Our students and staff have returned invigorated from a relaxing summer and are ready for a prosperous year of learning and fun at CVPS.

As our school community continues to grow so do our classes. From June to September our school population has gone from 683 to 735, and each year we are losing approximately 50 grade 8s, while adding 100 JKs. We have reached a point where the school is full and we have 8 portables to support the increase in size. In meeting with the York Region District School Board Planning Department, it was decided that we must now begin to lower the number of students entering Cornell Village Public School. As a result, new registrants to CVPSA will be overflowed to assist us with our crowded situation. Below is an explanation of what this will involve at Cornell Village Public School beginning October 1, 2009:

- All new registrants who live on White's Hill Road, including all homes on Black Creek Drive will overflow to Little Rouge Public School.
- All families with a child currently enrolled in CVPS, who have younger siblings (not yet registered) living in this area will continue to register at CVPS and will not be impacted by the overflow situation. We will not have siblings attending different schools due to overflow.
- This is not a boundary change. A new school is proposed for the Cornell community for 2013 in the Capital Strategy. The elementary site is located east of Cornell Centre Blvd. The Capital Strategy is reviewed on an annual basis and modifications are made if necessary. A Boundary process will commence for the new school at a later date.

It is our intent that families currently enrolled at CVPS will *NOT* be affected by this change. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me at your convenience.
